
Bingo Chat Rooms

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While going out to play bingo live is as much about the social aspect as it is about the game, **online bingo** offers more than you might think in the way of socialising. Chatting with your friends during a game isn't the same as playing online, but lots of bingo sites have chatrooms that let you talk to other players while you're playing. Chatting through your computer helps you meet people from all around the world and you can join in with the community on the site as well as enter extra games that happen in the **chat rooms**. Some of the games are just for fun but you can win prizes in many of them too. On this page we talk about etiquette in bingo site chat rooms along with the games that happen during chat.

Etiquette For Bingo Chat Rooms

Chat rooms help to make the online bingo experience more sociable and allow players to interact with each other, but it's important to note the etiquette for chatting with other members of a site. These rules are about good manners but it can detract from the **fun of games** if there is any abuse in the chat room. Treating others with courtesy and how you'd like to be treated yourself is the first rule of etiquette. Comments that could be misconstrued, as abuse should be avoided and making fun of other players for losing a game is a definite no-no of the chat rooms. Not making prejudiced comments is another important rule and you should refrain from mentioning controversial or inappropriate topics. As a final rule, you should take note of the chat moderators as they are in charge. They also control the additional games that happen in chat rooms.

Bingo Site Chat Room Games

Bingo sites often provide extra prizes for chat room games, as they want the chat rooms to be enjoyable so players stay for more bingo games. The prizes may be small but there are often lots of them so you'll have a good chance of winning. The games are free and usually simple to play so there are lots of varieties and they won't distract you from the main bingo game. There are three main types of games- number games, trivia games and buddy games. Number games are connected to the bingo game. For example you could win by picking a number which is then chosen by the moderator and having your number called first during the game. Trivia games are based on general knowledge and you could win a prize for being the first player to give the correct answer. Buddy games allow you to win by having something in common with a winner, such as the first letter of the winner's username. By taking part in the chat you'll be able to **learn about the games and find out just how many different ones there are**.

Chat Room Acronyms
