
What is free bingo no deposit?

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Yes, you read correctly, play bingo online for free. What's the catch? Well, there isn't one – **you really can play bingo online without a deposit**. As tempting as it may sound, you'll probably be wondering what the deal is. Read on to learn everything you need to know about free bingo online.

What does no deposit mean?

Just that; no deposit. This type of bingo game is aimed directly at **newbies wanting to indulge in some bingo fun**. When you join, you'll simply be given a bonus (in the form of bingo bucks), which typically ranges between £5 and £20, although sometimes if you're lucky, it may be higher. It's a great deal, but of course there's something behind it all. Online bingo sites that offer bingo games without any form of deposit are using these offers to lure you in and encourage you to continue playing – it's all part of their marketing plan.

Bingo Bucks? What are they?

These are your dollars, euros, pounds, or whatever currency you go by, but they're a form of virtual money which is especially used for online bingo games. Credited to your personal online bingo account, you'll be able to claim these as soon as you've signed up and verified your email. This online credit will allow you to **play bingo online** and in some cases the slots depending on which site you sign up with. Unfortunately, your free bingo bucks are not cash redeemable, meaning they can't be withdrawn from your account, however, each bingo site varies, so make sure you read the terms and conditions carefully before signing up.

What's the point of free bingo money and what can you do with it?

Your free bingo money allows you to test the waters and explore which site you like the best. Once you've used your bingo bucks up, you're not obliged to permanently join any site; the choice is yours.

What happens when you win?

Again every online bingo site is different and has different rules, which is why it's imperative to carefully read the terms and conditions before committing yourself to just one site. With most sites, there's typically a **wagering requirement**, however, it's quite insignificant compared to our casino loving friends and what they have to pay out when they win big. But to be clear, you'll always need to pay some form of deposit (the site's commission) before you'll be able to withdraw your winnings.

Why are there fewer online bingo sites offering free bingo credit?

Unfortunately, that's the way the game has evolved. These days most online bingo companies prefer to give away a larger and more **attractive deposit bonus**, meaning you'll have to invest first before you even have the chance to win. The biggest issue that many online bingo sites have faced in the past is that there have been a number of cases when their bingo players have simply abused the system. Players sign up using different names and create many free accounts, giving them access to more free bingo bucks than they're allowed. Online bingo operators of course still want to attract interested punters, which is why they usually offer attractive bonuses on a player's first deposit.

To play free bingo or not to play free bingo, that's the question

What have you got to lose? When you get free bingo bucks, why not? When online bingo operators offer such incentives, there are usually no strings attached. It's a case of spending what you've been given. Naturally, you'll be expected to pay a small commission fee when you do win and you want to claim your winnings, but in all fairness, this is to be expected; how else are they going to make a profit? It is a business after all.
