
Withdrawing Your Winnings At Bingo Sites

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When you are looking for the ideal bingo site to play on, stipulations regarding wagering requirements can often go ignored. You'll often find that the rules regarding the withdrawing of your winnings is expressed at the end of the page as small print. Your concentration is deliberately drawn to the eye-catching promotions and offers, rather than comparatively arduous wagering requirements. It's also not uncommon that the most attractive promotions designed to get bingo enthusiasts to sign up and start playing, come with pretty stringent wagering stipulations attached. Such hefty requirements typically equate to winners being forced to wager their winning or bonuses a number of times prior to them being able to get their hands on the funds. It is important to note that the bigger the bonus is that you claim, you will have to wager a larger amount before you are able to withdraw any of the funds. With this in mind, it may be more beneficial to make a small deposit as you will then be able to make a withdrawal sooner rather than later.

Minimal withdrawal limits

Another aspect of many bingo sites that can have a tendency to go overlooked, is related to withdrawal limits. Many sites have rules in place that players cannot withdraw their winnings or bonuses until their funds reach a specified amount. If the funds are not high enough to withdraw, players are forced to keep playing and attempting to win until the amount reaches the required withdrawal milestone. Reaching £20 is the average amount players have to get to before they can withdraw their funds on many bingo sites. In order to not be disappointed by being unable to withdraw money prior to reaching the withdrawal amount, it is advisable that players read the small print on a bingo site.

Low wagering requirements

With the general tendency not to read the small print and be informed about wagering stipulations of a site, bingo sites with **low wagering requirements** can often go missed. The following sites offer low wagering requirements, regardless of their pretty generous welcome bonuses. . **Kitty Bingo** requires 2 times the bonus plus the deposit amount. **Mainstage Bingo** requires 2 times the bonus plus the deposit amount. **Panda Bingo** requires 2 times the bonus plus the deposit amount. **Ladbrokes Bingo** requires 2 times the bonus plus the deposit amount

No wagering requirements

However, there are a few bingo sites in existence that don't express any wagering requirements. Naturally such sites are popular, although you should be aware that it is normal practice with **online bingo** that players are required to make a deposit before participating in any of the games and having the chance of collecting winnings. Whilst it isn't easy to find a site with no wagering requirements, they do exist, so perseverance to keep looking is likely to pay.

Read the terms and conditions

The moral of the wagering requirements story is to always read the terms and conditions before committing to play on a specific site and making a deposit. Each bingo site is different and their terms and conditions can be significantly varying.
